Meetings re the future of the BAE site – 6.30pm Jan 27th at Woodford Community Centre

The Stockport Council area committee covering Woodford, Bramhall and Cheadle is to hold a meeting in which there will be an “open forum relating to the future of the BAE Woodford site”. A presentation will be given by Paul Rubinstein, Stockport Council’s Service Director for Regeneration. The meeting will be on **Thursday, January 27th starting at 6.30pm in Woodford Community Centre**. Does the council have any major news to announce? It is certainly the case that events are moving rapidly at Woodford, with the Nimrods being “chopped up for scrap” (to quote the *Daily Telegraph*). If you are interested in developments on the airfield, and the impact that they will have upon the future of Woodford, please come along to the meeting.

Many thanks to all who have helped to increase the circulation of Woodford Community Council’s newsletter.
